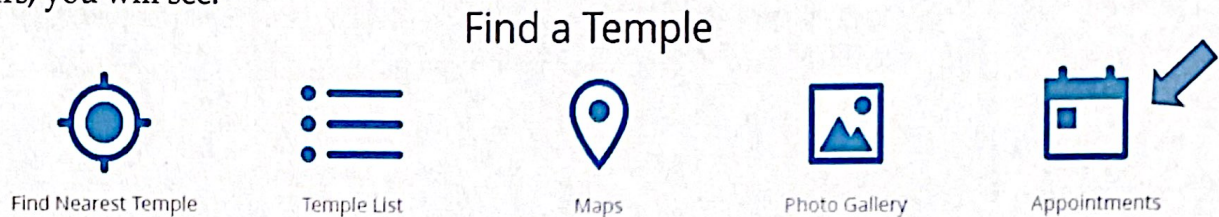


TEMPLE APPOINTMENT PROCEDURE

1. Go to the Church website www.churchofjesuschrist.org and sign-in to your account.

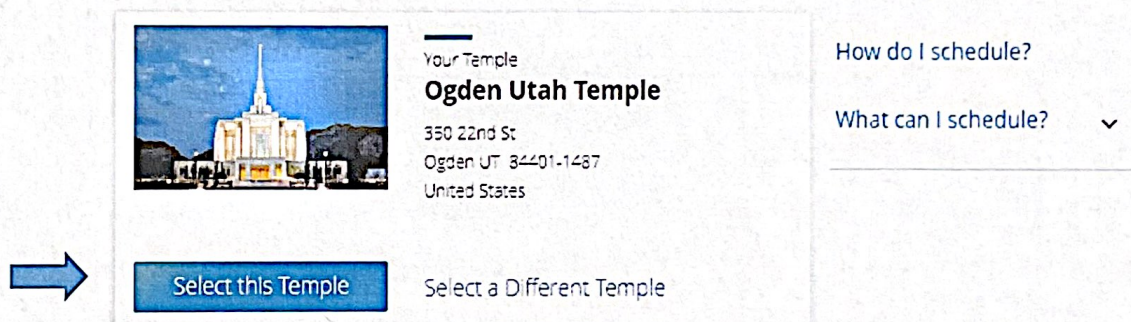
(NOTE: If you don't have an account, you can create one. If you have forgotten your password, you can get a new one. Don't let this deter you from proceeding! Contact a ward T&FH consultant if you need help.)

2. Under the "Serve" tab near the top of the page, select "Temples". On the following page that appears, you will see:



3. Select "Appointments". This action will take you to the Ogden Utah Temple page for scheduling appointments. Select "Select this Temple" (or "Select a Different Temple" if you choose).

(NOTE: Individual members and families may attend any temple they desire.)

4. Follow appointment steps 1-3 by selecting the ordinance you wish to perform (step 1), the date you wish to attend from the calendar icon (step 2), and then finalize your appointment (step 3).

(NOTE: When selecting certain ordinances, you will have the option of adding others to your appointment who will be attending with you, such as your spouse, or those helping with sealings or baptisms.)

5. Once you finalize your appointment, you can then schedule another appointment for a different type of ordinance at the same temple by making the selection at the top of the page.

All appointment times are in the local time zone of the temple.

(NOTE: You cannot schedule another appointment for the same ordinance, at the same temple, through your own account, until the date of your current appointment has past. However, a spouse can also schedule appointments under their own account irrespective of yours, so you could perform two sessions together of the same ordinance on the same day.)

6. You are all set to go the temple!!!!

TEMPLE OPERATION STATUS

Individual members and families may attend any temple they desire. All reopening temples have implemented an online appointment system for participation in temple ordinances, as well as safety protocols requiring the wearing of masks for patrons and workers.

Available temple ordinance appointments often fill rapidly. Please don't let this deter you from attending the temple. Patrons are encouraged to plan and schedule their appointments well in advance, and to check back often for new openings resulting from cancellations or added capacity.


Where one temple may have no appointments available on the day you wish to attend, another temple just a short drive away may have many openings for that same time. We encourage you to take the opportunity to patronize the many beautiful temples nearby when appointments are not readily available at the temple of your choice.

TAKE A NAME TO THE TEMPLE

When you go to the Church website www.churchofjesuschrist.org and sign-in to your account, your personal “Dashboard” will appear. At the bottom-right corner of your Dashboard, you will see a box entitled “Take a Name to the Temple”.

Select a temple ordinance

If you would like to use this feature to obtain a name to take to the temple, select the type of temple ordinance you wish to perform, and then select “Find a Name”. You will receive ordinances from your own reservation list, from your tree, or from names already submitted to the temple.

NOTE: If taking a name to the temple that you had pre-printed from some time ago, you are encouraged to first verify on FamilySearch that the ordinance you wish to perform has not already been performed for that person, which can happen when duplicate names have been merged by others.
