Contest Rules and Instructions for Entry:

Grow A Smile Program Rules & Guidelines

The "Grow A Smile" program encourages children and teens (ages 17 and under) in Dearborn County to establish excellent daily oral hygiene habits for lifelong health.

1. **@** Eligibility

Participants: The program is open to all children and teens aged 17 and under who reside in Dearborn County.

Registration: Each eligible participant will receive one (1) Starter Brushing Kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, and floss) and one (1) Brushing & Flossing Calendar upon joining the program.

2. Monthly Entry Requirements

To qualify for the quarterly drawing, participants must demonstrate a whole month of consistent oral hygiene:

Completion: The participant must complete one whole month (30 consecutive days) of brushing their teeth twice a day and flossing once a day.

Documentation: This must be tracked and certified using the official Brushing & Flossing Calendar provided in the Starter Brushing Kit. All 60 spaces (AM/PM brushing, 30 days) and 30 flossing spaces must be marked or initialed by the child (if age appropriate) and/or a parent/guardian.

Submission: The completed calendar must be turned in to the Dearborn County Health Department before the first of the month

3. Drawing Entry Limit

Maximum Entries: Each eligible child may submit a maximum of one (1) completed calendar entry per calendar month.

Example: A child who submits completed calendars in November, December, and January would have three separate entries in the January drawing. No Rollover: Entries are valid only for the next scheduled quarterly drawing after the submission date.

4. T Quarterly Drawing & Prizes

Drawing Schedule: Drawings will be held four times a year:

January (for entries submitted in Oct, Nov, Dec)

April (for entries submitted in Jan, Feb, Mar)

July (for entries submitted in Apr, May, Jun)

October (for entries submitted in Jul, Aug, Sep)

Prize: Each drawing will select one winner who will receive a Home Mini-Hydroponics Kit to grow their own fruits and vegetables.

Notification: Winners will be notified using the contact information provided on their submission. Prizes must be picked up at the Dearborn County Health Department within 30 days of notification.

One Prize Per Child: A child can win a prize only once per 12-month period (e.g., if a child wins in January, they are not eligible to win again until the following January).

5. A Parent/Guardian Responsibility

Oversight: A parent or legal guardian must monitor the child's daily habits and sign the calendar to verify that the brushing and flossing requirements are completed before submission.

Integrity: The Dearborn County Health Department reserves the right to verify participation and disqualify any entry believed to be fraudulent or incomplete.
