

# **Featured KCHN Client Story**

The KCHN SHIBA volunteer recently met with an elderly Kittitas County resident to review their financials and insurance documents and quickly determined that they would qualify for more than what they were currently getting. KCHN worked together with ALTC to fill out Washington Connect applications to also help with food assistance. The client was so appreciative for the compassion, care, and attentiveness that ALTC and KCHN showed her. They qualified for their Medicaid premiums to be covered in full so they will no longer have copays and/or deductibles. Before KCHN's help, because of their medical bills, they were struggling to pay for basic necessities such as food. Not only did KCHN help with Medicare & ALTC helped with food assistance applications, but most importantly, this client felt cared for, treated with kindness and respect, and as a
