Do you suffer from arm pain and/or swelling caused by secondary lymphedema?

Learn more about a new treatment study that may offer relief.

Volunteers with symptoms of lymphedema in the upper limb(s) are needed for this exploratory study!

Genovus Biotechnologies and Brookside Physical Therapy are conducting an exploratory research study of a novel device that may treat upper body pain and swelling due to lymphedema.

This developmental device incorporates a quartz window paired with a pulsed electromagnetic field (PEMF) device. The quartz is treated in a way that researchers believe may modify electromagnetic fields during treatment.

<u>Non-invasive</u> and <u>drug-free</u>, this device will be examined as it pulses specific muscles with subsequent measurements to gauge results. Preliminary research indicates very little risk to participants and few or no side effects or discomfort.

The primary outcome of the study is expected to be changes in feelings of pain/heaviness and possible changes in limb circumference. If the treatment works, the potential benefit is that you may have reduced pain/heaviness and reduced swelling in affected area.

TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS STUDY

- You must be between the ages of 18–80.
- You must reside in Colorado or a neighboring state.
- The average time commitment for participants is expected to be 10 hours over a 2-week period.
