Players Code of Conduct Agreement

WHEN PLAYING FOOTBALL FOR CYFC I WILL:

- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team.
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, dive, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – I will shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me.
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team and not one individual player.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at CYFC.
- I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by CYFC, county FA or The FA:

I UNDERSTAND I MAY:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club.

IN ADDITION:

- CYFC, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
- CYFC, County FA or the FA could impose a fine and suspension against myself and/or the club.
- Any fines issued to myself by my CYFC, County FA or The FA shall be paid by my myself/parents/carers and will be paid within 4 working weeks of issue. Failure to make payment for any fines incurred may result in suspension until such fines are paid in full.

I /WE WILL:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Respect the Referee's decisions even when you don't agree with them
- Appreciate good play from whatever team it comes from
- Remain behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Support positively and offer players encouragement not criticism
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- I/We understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken:

I/WE MAY BE:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents.

IN ADDITION:

- CYFC, County FA, The FA could impose a fine and/or suspension to myself and/or on the club.
- Any fines issued to myself by CYFC, County FA or The FA shall be paid by myself and will be paid within 4 working weeks of issue. Failure to make payment for any fines incurred may result in suspension to myself or my child until such fines are paid in full.
