The gospel originally addresses Jesus' words to his disciples - at this point only the first 4 have been called - Andrew, Peter, James and John. Either one of them or a person in the crowd that followed after Jesus had an amazing memory. Each word is important - each word counts and there are three chapters of words that cover an array of topics.

I am struck by how careful Matthew is to convey both the seriousness of what was happening around Jesus and the disciples as well as his positive words and expectations of Jesus as he formed the growing group of disciples. They would, in a few short years become the Church - the body of Christ in the world. We are - by God's grace - them! Jesus' words to them are also to us. Look at Matthew 5:13-20 in preparation for our Sunday worship together.

Shrove Tuesday in February

FPC's celebration of Shrove Tuesday sees us partnering again with St. Edmund's Episcopal Church in Pfrangle Hall. Last year nearly 100 people came to eat and enjoy fellowship. This year's date is **Tuesday, Feb. 17 from 5-7 p.m.**

Please plan to be a part of this all-you-can- eat dinner. It's pancakes, sausage, toast, orange juice, coffee, and water.

Tickets are **\$8** and can be purchased in the front office or from Jill. Tickets can also be bought at the door.

Mardi Gras, synonymous with Carnival celebrations in New Orleans, Venice and Rio, is marked in similarly festive fashion around the world.

However, what began as a holiday rooted in religious tradition has become a cultural phenomenon, leading to parties for the sake of partying, and not necessarily in anticipation of 40 days of penance between Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday.

Along the way, **Shrove Tuesday** emerged as the last day of Shrovetide, the week preceding the start of Lent. The word **Shrovetide** is the English equivalent of Carnival, which comes from the Latin words *carnem levare*, meaning "to take away the flesh."

To prepare for Lent, Christians prepared pancakes to deplete their stock of eggs, milk, butter and fat, giving rise to Pancake Day in England. As the tradition spread through Europe, it became Mardi Gras in France, where waffles and crepes are prepared as part of a lavish feast.
