This is a humbling week as we think of conflict in our hemisphere and category 5 Hurricane Melissa. As always it is the normal people about whom I worry most. Having traveled to places like Venezuela and Haiti and Jamaica, I am struck by the thin margin within which they live in a beautiful island setting somehow spread over with poverty and hard living. I have also had the opportunity to work with Cubans in various settings and have benefited from their dedication to medical education and mission. Our church partner in Cuba is the Presbyterian Church of Cuba which has marvelous leaders who have impact in many places. In Venezuela there is a very small Presbyterian denomination. In Haiti our partner church people are Episcopalians and in Jamaica there are several Reformed Christian churches that work in conjunction with Canadian and U.S. Presbyterians. These are real people whose faces are known and to whose stories we have been connected.

They do and will need our help.

We are among those who have an opportunity to share the abundant grace in which we live - especially those of us in Florida who know what hurricanes can do and who have been recipients of shared grace ourselves.

We can give thanks that the storm is past, but the suffering and need are still with us.

Please let us pray for these brothers and sisters and let us do what we can to stand with them and help them find restoration.
