Secondly, I feel trepidation as the Gospel Lesson include that most famous verse - John 3:16. I thought about using some other passage but believe I need to stick to this one. On the one hand, everyone thinks they know what it means, so maybe if I mumble gently people will just automatically stick in the own thoughts and then everyone will go home happy. On the other hand, there is a reason this passage is so well loved. So we will look at John 3:14-21. As much as I would like to skip it, this is Lent and it fits well here.

Even I now have my first vaccination. It was a very smooth and choreographed process at the clinic I went to. The shot was painless and, while I got sleepy, I did not feel bad in any way. I hope these injections we are all getting, by the grace of God, the beginning of the end of this pandemic.

Please continue to pray for those whose jobs and families and lives have been more impacted than ours have been - especially those in parts of the world where medical care is limited or priced above affordability.

Saturday, March 20 at 11am we will have a memorial service for our beloved organist, Charles Dirr. If you attend please wear a mask and maintain social distance. It would be ironic if the service became a 'spreader-event' when Charles loved us all and would only want the best for us.
