Charles's Memories.....

Each week we will have a special memory of Charles. We have so many that we thought it would be a great idea to just add it to the E-Blast each week. So if you have a special memory of Charles send me an e-mail or call me at the office. Memory from Pastor Tim Stewart: In the years that I was privileged to work with Charles at Burnt Store Presbyterian Church, although I have many fond memories of our time together, I will share only a few.

Shortly after he became our accompanist Charles was in the sanctuary rehearsing prior to choir practice. I heard him playing a piece with which I was unfamiliar, but

it was amazing. I went to him and asked if he might play that as his postlude at the end of our upcoming Easter Sunday service. He agreed and it was marvelous. I noticed that when he played it he had no music before him. When I asked him about that he told me that the piece he played was such that one could not play from the music – it had to be memorized. I had no idea what I was asking Charles to do but he did it without hesitation – and he played it perfectly.

Fast forward to a Sunday in August 2020 when I had the opportunity to preach at First Presbyterian Church in Arcadia. When he auditioned for the position at Burn Store Charles played an offertory piece that I remember to this day. The song was "Praise Him, Praise Him (Jesus our Blessed Redeemer).' After the audition and interview I spoke with Charles and raved about that piece. I told him how it took me back to my childhood church... to one of my favorite hymns. As an honor to me when I preached in Arcadia on that August Sunday, Charles played "Praise Him,"

Finally, Charles always called me "Brother Tim" and I dearly loved it. He was only the second person to call me that, the other being a wonderful woman who was a member of the church I served immediately before Burnt Store. Brother Charles, I will miss you. You are one of a kind and I look forward to seeing you in eternity.
