Dear Saints:

This third Sunday of Easter we jump from the Gospel according to John and its stories of the resurrection. We jump to the Gospel according to Luke and its story of the resurrected Jesus appearing to the disciples in the upper room. Why the lectionary switches gospels I am not sure, but let's trust that there is a reason. We will see Jesus going to great lengths to help the disciples understand that he really is himself and that he is alive. He will carefully teach them how scripture foretold all that had happened.

The Jesus says they are the 'witnesses' to these things? What does it mean to be a witness? My experience as a child taught me to want to leave the room quickly if someone said they wanted to 'witness.' I didn't like peoples' stories in which they themselves starred and in which they were very good at making themselves look bad so they could look good. I felt they wanted to be admired both for the depth and cleverness of their sin <u>and</u> for the noble transformed people they became after they repented.

I think my instincts were right but if we wrest the word 'witness' back from them and listen to what it means to Jesus, what is it saying about who Jesus wants us to be and how we get there. Let's think about this Sunday as Jesus calls the disciples to witness to something that seemed impossible to them – Jesus alive again and with them!
