News from Pastor Will......

Dear Saints of FPC Arcadia,

Thank you for your warm welcome on my first Sunday with you. Thanks to my first time with you when I was your interim pastor - which was wonderful for me, I really do feel at home again. Even with all the current necessary restrictions, I am very happy to be back with you.

As usual for me, I am following the Common Lectionary for scripture passages from which to preach. This week that takes me to Romans 14:1-12 and Matthew 18:21-35. The sermon title will be "Obligations of Grace."

As we begin this next chapter of the epic story of FPC Arcadia, my mind is on the theology of the church (which scholars call Ecclesiology). What makes the church the church? What is God's intention for the church? What are the promises and limitations of the church? How does FPC Arcadia find its unique place within the parameters of what the church is as the body of Christ in the world?

I want to think about the church for a while because:

- it is in thinking about the Church that I believe we will find assurance and hope and purpose;
- it is in thinking about the church that we will find our imaginations re-fired enabling us to discern God's word for us in this time; and
- it is in thinking about the church we will remember and be strengthened by the ways the church has responded to God's call in the past.

Our scriptures for Sunday deal with forgiveness. Now my message will not be an attempt to make you feel guilty – rather it will be about what it means that we are a community of the forgiven and the forgiving.

Look forward to seeing you Sunday in person or on the web.
