Session Highlights –

Session highlights from the September 21, 2020 meeting:

The following were items the session took action on:

- 1. Approved repair of the duplex roof and bulletin board in the front of the church. The new roof for the duplex will cost approximately \$17,000 and the repair of the bulletin board will cost \$465.
- 2. Approved having the chancel choir to resume singing at the morning worship. Date to be determined by the director and the choir.
- 3. Approved setting aside the current method of selection for the nominating team and return to the previous method.
- 4. Approved the restart of Sunday school. Starting times to be determined by the class facilitator and the class members.
- 5. Approved the return of the Wednesday night suppers for discussion at the Annual Congregational meeting.

6. Approved Annual Congregational meeting for October 11 and a Congregational meeting for Nov. 1, 2020.

The following were items were reported during the session meeting:

- 1. The church has \$43,810 in the checking account, \$12,836 in restricted giving, and \$88,824 in savings.
 - 2. The Christmas program is scheduled for December 20, 2020.
