Dear Saints Who are First Presbyterian Church of Arcadia,

This Advent season I am looking at the beginning of each Gospel and how the author chose to start telling Jesus' story. Last week we looked at the Prologue of the Gospel According to John. John goes all the way back before time and creation and begins the story in the eternal being of God.

This week we look to the Gospel According to Matthew. Matthew also begins before Jesus is born. In fact he takes us back all the way to God's calling of Abraham and tracks all the generations of descendants until Joseph. He does this with a genealogy, which in the days of King James English was call the 'begats.' That is, "Abraham begat Isaac and Isaac begat Jacob..."

Modern versions say, "Abraham was the father of Isaac and Isaac was the father of Jacob..."

Besides challenging the pronunciation skills of the liturgical read, list of who was father to whom seems strange to us today. Many writers suggest we think about this as an ancient genogram which a tool to study the patterns of the recent generations in our family in order to better understand ourselves. This list goes back 42 generations! And, as with most family histories, we encounter surprises and shocks. All was not as noble and faithful as we thought it was.

The list in the Gospel according to Matthew is one way of telling us who Jesus was – which is not a bad way to prepare for our Christmas celebration of Jesus' birth! ... but watch out for the surprises – there is some shocking stuff here!


