Dear Saints of FPC,

As a general rule we have followed the Common Lectionary with its selected scripture passages in determining the focus of our worship. This has some great advantages as it leads us to look at what scripture teaches us rather than at messages we impose on scripture. But for a season I want to follow a different stream. I want to use two of our confessions or statements of faith to challenge and guide us in our thinking about our relationship with God.

We used "A Brief Statement of Faith" last Sunday. Starting this Sunday, I would like to listen as the "Declaration of Faith" guides our thinking about what scripture is telling us. Like the "Brief Statement of Faith" the "Declaration of Faith" is trinitarian - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The former started with lifting up Jesus as the chief form of God's revelation to us of who God is. the 'Declaration: begins more traditionally with God the Father.

"The Declaration of Faith" originally came out of the Southern stream of the Presbyterian Church but its rich language and clarity of expression have made it helpful for the whole church. Early drafts of the Declaration were being worked on when I was in seminary at Vanderbilt Divinity School. Some of its authors taught me.

Please join with us as we enjoy the freshness and power of this Declaration as we live in and rejoice in our faith.
