For me this is big deal and I confessed that when I began my service as Pastor of the First United Presbyterian Church of East Brady, PA. The ordination took place in the Reynodlsville Presbyterian Church where my father was serving as Pastor and of which I was then a member. My mother, who had by then been a longtime missionary in India gave me the 'charge' for my upcoming ministry. Her charge was direct and delivered with a pointing finger that left me no escape. She charged me to tithe my salary and to take a day off - because I was mortal and no stronger than I needed to be.

I had not had any great expectations of the service. It was a necessary step forward if I was to serve the church. Yet the actual event floored me and changed me. I found myself empowered by the Spirit to gifts of ministry that had not previously been a part of my makeup.

I found I could overcome my nervousness and speak clearly to my congregation. I could come up with creative new ways to organize the church and I was made aware and grateful for the wonderful people who were the congregation I served. The wonderful people have been a part of every church I have served since and their gifts and service has been the heart of how those churches touched the communities in which they and I served God.

Finally, I discovered my ministry was about grace. People seemed, like me, to be very aware of their shortcomings and failure and sin. The hard part was to assure

them that God's grace was greater than our sin and that it was God's power, not my power or their power, that changed the church and the world.

Now, to my amazement, it is 50 years later and I am still a minister and still reliant on grace. I thank God that I serve with you as this part of Christ's body, the church. Thanks be to God.
