Patriotic Bento Box Quarter Round Log Cabin P/F Block

This 10" block consists of only 5 pieces: a 6" blue square and a selection of four 2" red or white strips (finished sizes)

Alternate placement of blocks can give a "bento box" style design or a simple array of blocks with square placed in the same or alternating positions. Sashing and/or borders can be added to reach an appropriate lap size quilt.

Blue or a fabric that reads blue is the constant color for the square. (Start work well) *6 1/2" square center*

The 2 1/2" red and white strips are cut in units of W6 1/2", W8 1/2", R 8 1/2" and R10 1/2" or R6 1/2", R8 1/2", W 8 1/2" and W10 1/2". Place around square using quarter round log cabin format.
