Fabric- Children's fabric and cream

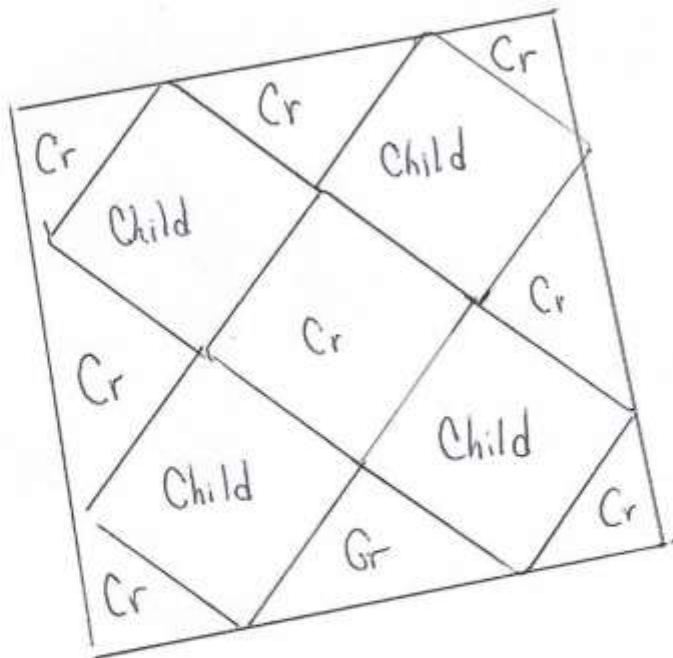
Cutting- Children's 4 4 3/4" sq.
