C'mon out, quilters, to learn something new, get a refresher, or just socialize and enjoy the fun evening.

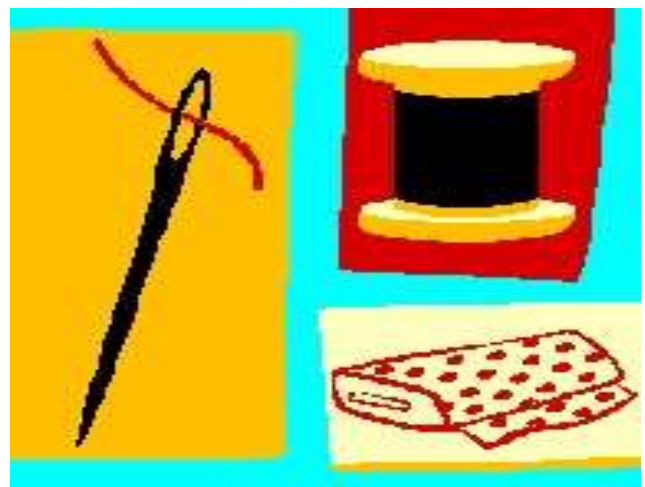


PROGRAMS Continued

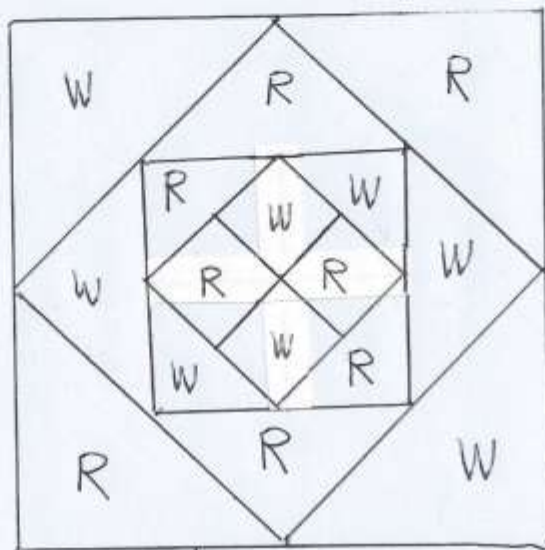
