Technique-Pieced

Block Size- 12 ½" c 12 ½"


Fabrics- white on white, red, gold, tan, med blue, dark blue

Cutting- white on white 1 4 ½" square

1 4 7/8" square 


Red 1 4 ½" square

Gold 1 4 ½" square

1 4 7/8" square 

Tan 2 4 ½" squares

Med. Blue 1 4 ½" square

1 4 7/8" square 

Dark blue 1 4 ½" square

Total pieces- 11

Med. Blue	Gold	Med. Blue white
Red	Dark Blue	Tan
Gold white	Tan	White
