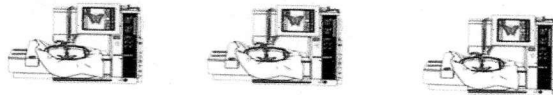

Fabrics-light and a dark print

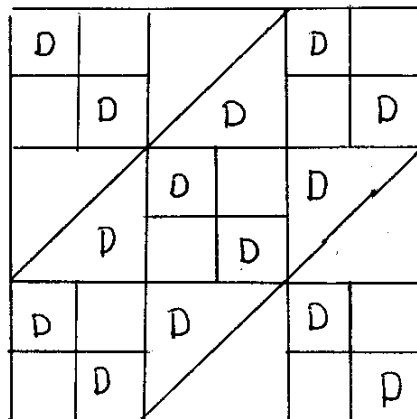
Cutting- light 2 4 7/8" squares cut on the diagonal

10 2 1/2" squares

Dark 2 4 7/8" squares cut on the diagonal

10 2 1/2" squares

Number of pieces-28
