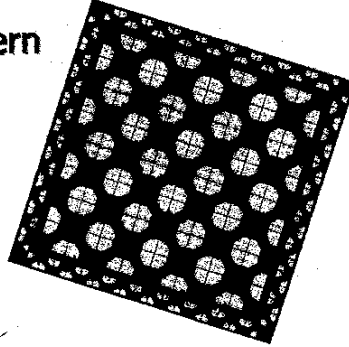

Quilts of Valor Bowtie Pattern

This block is a quick and easy one. Done in red, white, and blues it makes a fun pattern, no matter the setting.

The block is composed of 4 bowtie blocks, rotated to make an "X". Check out the fun quilt these X's make to the right.



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

(Let's go scrappy - try to use all different reds and blues!)

WHITE (Bleached Muslin, Tone-On-Tone, White Kona)
(8) 3 1/2" squares

RED: (4) 3 1/2" squares
(4) 2" squares - draw a diagonal line on wrong side of fabric

MED/DARK BLUE:
(4) 3 1/2" squares
(4) 2" squares - draw a diagonal line on wrong side of fabric

Begin by placing a RED 2" square, right sides together on top of a 3 1/2" WHITE square as shown. Stitch on the drawn line, trim 1/4" seam allowance, flip back and press.



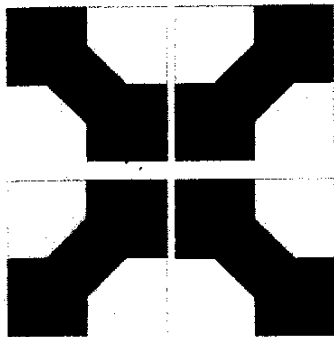
Make 4 red squares

Repeat the above process to make BLUE units.



Make 4 blue squares

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:



Arrange your blocks and Red and Blue squares as shown to the left. Your finished block should measure 12 1/2".
