
## **BLOCK OF THE MONTH**

- Fabric #C7: Blue Pinwheel #4
- Fabric #C8: Pink Pinwheel #1
- Fabric #C9: Pink Pinwheel #2
- Fabric #C10: Pink Pinwheel #3

# Prairie Pinwheels Taught by Cindy Myers

General Supply List

Prairie Pinwheels pattern by Judy Neimeyer.

Basic sewing supplies

Sewing Machine in good working order

Large cutting mat

45mm or 60 mm Rotary cutter with new blade, this is very important, you will be cutting through many layers of fabric at once!!

6x12 and 6x24 rulers

Small scissors

Seam ripper

Thread

Highlighter markers, at least 2 colors (optional)

Travel Iron and Ironing pad if allowed by facility (optional)

# Fabric Requirements

Please refer to the pattern for the necessary fabric amounts needed to complete the quilt.

# Paper Piecing Supplies

12" or 18" Add-A-Quarter Ruler

Heavy Template Plastic, 3" x 12" piece, (I will have this available in class for \$1)

Scotch Tape

Glue stick

Flower pins

Large ziplock bags

Binder clips

Large paper clips

# Pre-class Instructions

The pre-class instructions are very important and will get you ready to have a great day in class. The this will enable us to have more time for teaching and sewing and less time working on the small stuff.

- Please read through the written instructions, especially pages 1-3. This will help you understand the terminology that I will be using during the class.
- Place your swatches on the swatch list on page 3, this will help you to keep track
  of your fabrics when it comes time to start cutting. Get five (5) 1gal size ziplock
  bags and number them #1-#5.
- Watch the following You Tube video on How to cut your foundation papers.
   https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=X5DMxDfYlw0
   One thing that Judy forgets to mention is that when you are stacking your papers make sure that they are all the same papers.
- Follow the directions on page 3 for sorting and placing your cut foundation papers and template layout sheets in the correct amounts in their respective bags.
- Starting on page 4 with the Cutting Instructions: Fabric #C2, which is your background fabric. Cut the strips as listed and follow the instructions for sub cutting the strips on page 5, Step 1 and 2.
- 6. Follow Step 3 for more sub cutting. Please wait on Step 4-10.
- You can wait on cutting your fabric #C1 since this is your border fabric.
- 8. Follow instructions for cutting fabric #C3 starting on the bottom right of page 5.
- 9. Follow the instructions for cutting your fabrics #4 #11.

Now see that wasn't to bad, now you can sit back, relax and know you are ready for a great time in class.


