
Block of the Month

- ▶ We gift the SCV Senior Center with:
 - ▶ Lap quilts,
 - ▶ Shawls,
 - ▶ Placemats for meal recipients and volunteers
- ▶ Our Senior Center goals for 2021 are:
 - ▶ 18 wheelchair lap quilts: 36" x 48", with rounded corners
 - ▶ 18 shawls: 30" x 65"
 - ▶ 430 placemats for the Senior Center: 13" x 18"

 - ▶ Bib




Veterans

- Cal Vet apartments located on the VA property in La/Santa Monica
 - Give our California veterans a safe place to live
 - Individuals units with beds & a chair for reading or watching TV, etc
 - Care units for those whose health requires more attention
- We gift the Cal Vets with:
 - Bed size quilts: 60" X 80"
 - Lap quilts: 40-50" x 48-60"
 - Wheelchair quilt: 36" x 48", with rounded corners
 - Clothing protectors




- ▶ GDA provides hardworking dogs for people who are blind/visually impaired, veterans, and individuals with autism.
- ▶ We provide a quilt every other year for them to auction
- ▶ Members make dog-themed blocks
- ▶ Patti sews the blocks into one or more quilts



Habitat for Humanity
