
Scrappy Susannah Block Assembly

Your block should be 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square UNFINISHED. Finished Size (once sewn into the quilt) is 12".

For each block, you will need:

Fabric/Color White fabric (solid or small print) - Square Corners	Cut Size 3 ½" square	<u>Quantity</u> 4
- Square	3 ½" square	8
- Squares used for HSTs	4 ¼" square	2
Yellow		
- Squares used for HSTs	4 ¼" square	2

Create Half Square Triangles (HST) for Center

- 1. On the two (4 %") yellow squares, draw a diagonal line on wrong side of fabric.
- 2. Place each yellow square right side together with a 4 ¼" blue square. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line.
- 3. Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles (HST).
- 4. Open HSTs, press seam allowance toward the blue. Trim each HST to be a 3 %" square.
- 5. Layout squares as shown. Note this is a "scrappy" quilt. Only the color location matters. There is no set location for the different blues.
- 6. Using a scant ¼" seam, sew squares into rows.
- 7. Press each row. (Pressing seams open is recommended by some. Others prefer to press to one side. Your choice.)
- 8. Sew rows together, matching seams, and press block. Block should measure 12 1/2" square.


