## Scrappy Susannah Block Assembly

Your block should be $121 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square UNFINISHED. Finished Size (once sewn into the quilt) is 12 ".

For each block, you will need:

## Fabric/Color

White fabric (solid or small print)

- Square Corners

Mixture of Blues for Scrappy Look

- Square
- Squares used for HSTs

Yellow

- Squares used for HSTs

Cut Size
$31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
$31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
$41 / 4 "$ square
$41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square

## Create Half Square Triangles (HST) for Center

1. On the two ( $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ) yellow squares, draw a diagonal line on wrong side of fabric.
2. Place each yellow square right side together with a $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ blue square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of the drawn line.
3. Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles (HST).
4. Open HSTs, press seam allowance toward the blue. Trim each HST to be a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
5. Layout squares as shown. Note - this is a "scrappy" quilt. Only the color location matters. There is no set location for the different blues.
6. Using a scant $1 / 4$ " seam, sew squares into rows.
7. Press each row. (Pressing seams open is recommended by some. Others prefer to press to one side. Your choice.)
8. Sew rows together, matching seams, and press block. Block should measure 12 1/2" square.
