BLUE RIBBON WEAVE

Altered from Missouri Star Quilt

Your block should be 13" square UNFINISHED. Finished Size (once sewn into the quilt) is 12 1/2".

For each block, you will need:



Two Contrasting Prints (Primary Colors)



- 1. Fold (8) 3" background squares and (4) 3" print squares of each print on the diagonal, and press to crease. (Or draw diagonal guidelines.)
- 2. Place a creased background square on top of an uncreased print square, right sides facing. Sew on the creased line, then trim $\frac{1}{2}$ away from the sewn seam. Open and press.
- 3. Place a matching creased print square on top of the half-square triangle with the creased line crossing over the seam of the half-square triangle. Sew on the creased line, then trim ¼" away from the sewn seam. Open and press. Make 4 units of each selected print. Square to 3" as necessary.
- 4. Arrange the 8 units you have created, (4) 3" squares of each print, and (9) 3" background squares in 5 rows of 5 as shown.
- **5.** Sew the units together to form rows, then press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press.





