## BLUE RIBBON WEAVE

*** Note - You will have 3 squares of each of the two contrasting colors leftover. Please return those with the block so they can be used for the cornerstones and pieced border.***

Your block should be $13^{\prime \prime}$ square UNFINISHED. Finished Size (once sewn into the quilt) is $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

For each block, you will need:

Fabric/Color
Background fabric (Black))

- Squares

Cut Size

3" square
17

Two Contrasting Prints (Primary Colors)

- Squares

3" square
15 each***

1. Fold (8) 3 " background squares and (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ print squares of each print on the diagonal, and press to crease. (Or draw diagonal guidelines.)
2. Place a creased background square on top of an uncreased print square, right sides facing. Sew on the creased line, then trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seam. Open and press.
3. Place a matching creased print square on top of the half-square triangle with the creased line crossing over the seam of the halfsquare triangle. Sew on the creased line, then trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seam. Open and press. Make 4 units of each selected print. Square to 3 " as necessary.
4. Arrange the 8 units you have created, (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares of each print, and (9) $3^{\prime \prime}$ background squares in 5 rows of 5 as shown.
5. Sew the units together to form rows, then press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press.


FINISHED BLOCK

Block Size:
