## Chain Block

USE $1 / 4$ " SEAM ALLOWANCE

1. Using 2 small Colorful squares, with right sides together, sew together. Press seam in one direction.
2. Using above and a white rectangle, with right sides together, sew aong edge of rectangle. Press seam toward white.
3. Repeat to create 4 units.

## Combine Units

4. Follow layout placement and sew together in rows. .** If using the blue to coral colored kit, note the square with the pin and place that square in center.
5. Press middle row seams toward center, and top and bottom row seams toward the outside.
6. Nest seams of rows together. Press flat.


For a $60 \times 60$ quilt (no borders), you'll need 13 star blocks and 12 chain blocks. Lay out: $5 \times 5$ blocks.
