

Chain Block

Your block should be 12.5" UNFINISHED. Finished Size (once sewn into the quilt) is 12".
(aka the blocks that go between the stars to connect them all together.)

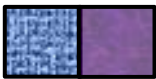
For each block, you will need:



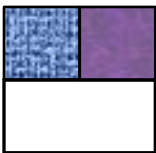
<u>Fabric/Color</u>	<u>Cut Size</u>	<u>Quantity</u>
White fabric		
- Rectangles	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	4
Colorful Fabrics		
- Center & Corner Squares	4 1/2" x 4 1/2"	5
*** For the kits with blue to coral colors, one of these squares has a pin in it to mark the square that should go in the center***		
- Small squares	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	8

USE 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE

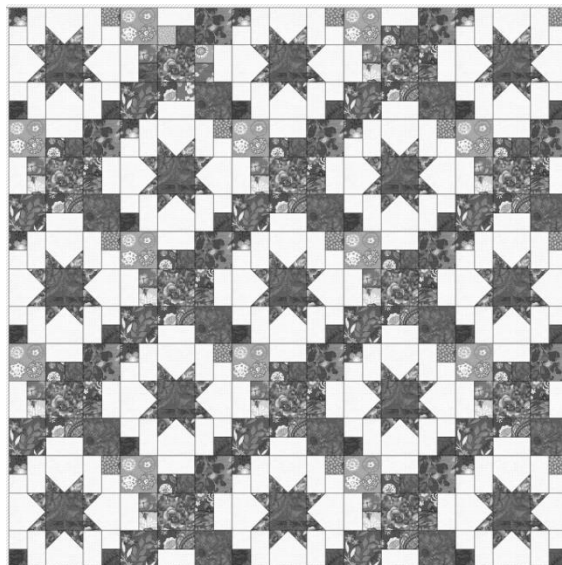
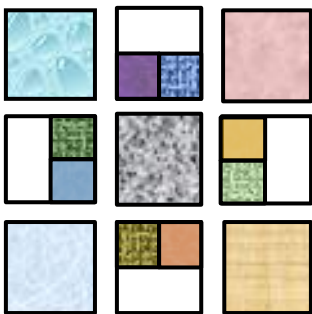


- Using 2 small Colorful squares, with right sides together, sew together. Press seam in one direction.
- Using above and a white rectangle, with right sides together, sew along edge of rectangle. Press seam toward white.
- Repeat to create 4 units.

Combine Units

- Follow layout placement and sew together in rows. *** If using the blue to coral colored kit, note the square with the pin and place that square in center.
- Press middle row seams toward center, and top and bottom row seams toward the outside.
- Nest seams of rows together. Press flat.

Step 4



For a 60x60 quilt (no borders), you'll need 13 star blocks and 12 chain blocks. Lay out: 5x5 blocks.
