*As I mentioned in the requirements, this design is set on point. We will cut those setting triangles first as they are our largest cuts for this design. There are some larger units along the way, but nothing too exciting. We will also cut and assemble a couple of our larger cut blocks in this clue.*

*First those setting triangles:*

<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>14" WOF strips</i>	<i>2-3</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 14" squares</i>	<i>5</i>	
<i>Cut squares on BOTH diagonals for triangles</i>	<i>18 (we cut 20)</i>	
<i>18-1/4" WOF strips</i>		<i>3</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 18-1/4" squares</i>		<i>5</i>
<i>Cut squares on BOTH diagonals for triangles</i>		<i>18 (we cut 20)</i>

*Please set these aside with your clues for the reveal. They will "square" our design.*

*Block A: four of these square in a square units*

<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>5-3/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>Scraps + 1</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 5-3/8" squares</i>	<i>8</i>	
<i>Cut squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>	<i>16</i>	
<i>6-7/8" WOF strips</i>		<i>Scraps + 1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 6-7/8" squares</i>		<i>8</i>
<i>Cut squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>		<i>16</i>

<b>ACCENT</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>6-7/8" WOF strips</i>	<b>1</b>	
<i>Sub-cut to 6-7/8" squares</i>	<b>4</b>	
<i>9" WOF strips</i>		<b>1</b>
<i>Sub-cut to 9" squares</i>		<b>4</b>

*How's that for easy??*

*I found the centre of the triangles and squares and finger pressed a little divot, mated them right sides together and stitched. These should measure 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" now. Press these toward the triangles.*



*Block B: eight of these partial "storm at sea" blocks*

*\*I decided to give you a template for these. I think I will also give you a diagram if you want to paper piece these... two options, please cut only ONE option. I will use the template option.*

<i>3-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<b>2</b>	
<i>Using the "Recs" tool cut triangles**</i>	<b>32 sets (64 triangles)</b>	
<i>2-3/8" WOF strips</i>	<b>1</b>	
<i>Sub-cut to 2-3/8" squares</i>	<b>16</b>	
<i>Cut squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>	<b>32</b>	

<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>4-1/2" WOF strips</i>		<i>2</i>
<i>Using the "Recs" tool cut triangles**</i>		<i>32 sets (64 triangles)</i>
<i>2-7/8" WOF strips</i>		<i>Scraps + 1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 2-7/8" squares</i>		<i>16</i>
<i>Cut squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>		<i>32</i>

**\*\*PLEASE** leave your fabric folded or place it RST so we will cut mirror image sets.

<b>ACCENT</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>6-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>2</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 6-1/2" squares</i>	<i>8</i>	
<i>8-1/2" WOF strips</i>		<i>2</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 8-1/2" squares</i>		<i>8</i>
<b>BOLD/STATEMENT</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>2-5/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 2-5/8" squares</i>	<i>8</i>	
<i>Measure your template first, then cut WOF strips</i>	<i>Only what you need</i>	
<i>Using template F, cut diamonds</i>	<i>16</i>	
<i>3-3/8" WOF strips</i>		<i>1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 3-3/8" squares</i>		<i>8</i>
<i>4-1/8" WOF strips (I did this size)</i>		<i>Only what you need</i>
<i>Using template F, cut diamonds</i>		<i>16</i>

*Just so you know what goes where:*

*Now let's break it down.*

*Top right corner: BOLD smallish squares and BACKGROUND triangles we cut in the charts.*

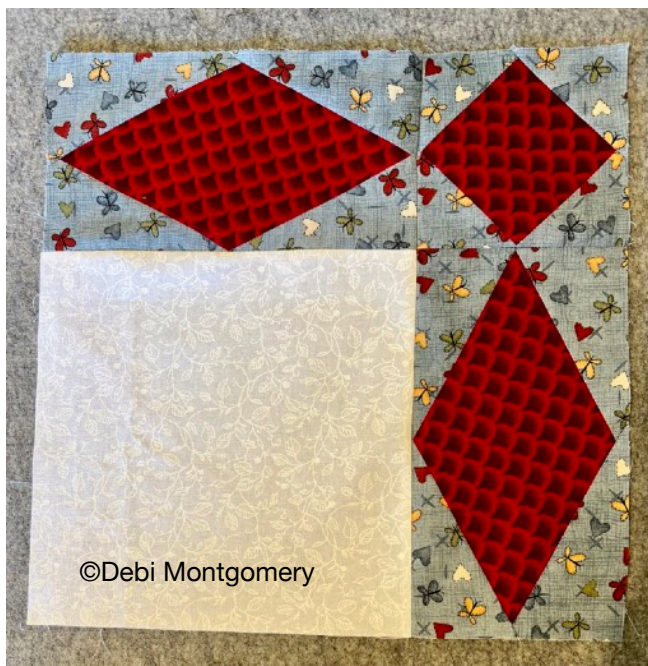
*Top left and side right: Template F and recs tool triangles.*

*Bottom left: ACCENT square.*

*Template F and recs diamonds:  
These should measure 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" OR 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"  
now*



*BOLD squares with triangles cut on page 3:  
These should measure 3-1/2" OR 4-1/2" now.*



*Complete, you should have EIGHT of these partial storm at sea blocks. These should now measure 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" and I pressed these toward the ACCENT to help keep the points and lay flat.*
