## BOM Mystery Quilt Part 2

## Step 3: Making Half-Square Triangles

Take 42 each of C (Background Fabric) and E (Focus Fabric) and make into half square triangles. Press to focus fabric. Trim to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Step 4: Making Accent Squares

Take 84 each of F (Medium Light Accent Fabric) and G (Medium Dark Accent Fabric) and sew into pairs. Press to the darker fabric.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR NINE-PATCH BLOCKS

1. The block kit contains $2 \cdot 5$-inch strips cut from a darker and lighter fabric. Sew a dark fabric strip to each side of a lighter fabric strip, then crosscut into 2.5 inch-wide units creating "Unit A". Press the $1 / 4$ " seams to the darker fabric.
2. Sew a lighter fabric strip to each side of a darker fabric strip and then crosscut into 2.5 inch-wide units creating "Unit B". Press the $1 / 4$ " seams to the darker fabric.
3. Complete the nine-patch block by sewing a Unit A to the top and bottom of a Unit B. At this point, the block should measure 6.5 inches by 6.5 inches.
