SNOWFLAKES BY PATTI VOYLES

Created through a Debbie Mumm Club project at Blazing Star. Fabric from her collection. Snowflakes are quilted with a large stitch embroidery thread. The remainder was machine quilted using free motion on a home machine. I chose to make it with green as the primary color and used red in the quilting. I have a matching pillow too!

I found this cute snowman panel last summer and made it into a quilted advent calendar by attaching velcro dots to each snowman and present, and the matching velcro dot to red bows. Each day, a bow is added to the quilt. There is a pocket in the top left corner to store the bows.

I made this wall hanging in Dec 2018. The hills are appliqued and the snowman and text are machine-embroidered. The big snowflakes are the fabric print, but the smaller ones are embroidered.

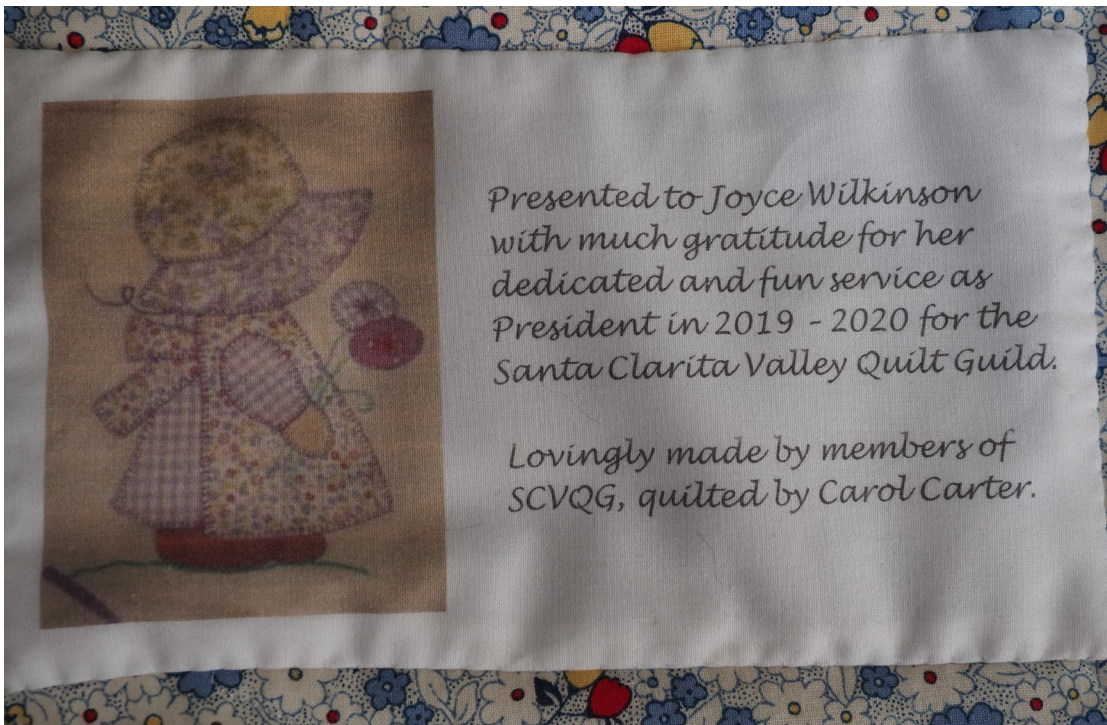
