They are now looking for bed quilts in this unit and I will see what we can put together from the odd blocks I have. I would like to try for a sewing day in July - Wednesday is best for me. I can bring in a large table if we have enough participants. I have blocks and sashing fabric that could make 10 tops. Please feel free to contact me with a Wednesday you are available in July!

I will be taking the donations we have completed to the VA this month. They will include the items hanging at city hall and several more that are in storage. For this work - as a reminder - the Rehab unit needs clothing protectors (the vests), lap quilts, wheel chair quilts and bed quilts. 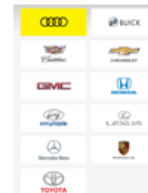
