## FUN FACTS

Do you know how to care for your OLFA Rotary Cutting Mat? In order to clean and condition your green Olfa rotary mat, you can actually give it a bath!

Put your mat in the bathtub and use 1/4 cup white vinegar to a gallon of tepid (not hot) water, and a couple of drops (squirt) of a mild dishwashing soap. Using a mushroom brush (or other mild bristle brush), create a lather and gently clean and condition mat. Rinse the mat and let dry or dry with a Turkish towel. The mats love moisture. It helps keep them supple. Be sure to store them flat and out of direct sunlight.


