If you are still interested, be sure to see me at the May meeting – we might be able to squeeze in one or two more people...For her workshop, Roberta requests that you bring as many scraps as you like – she will bring a bunch, too – the brighter, the better! She has one pattern that only requires two colors – and can be scraps or not. You should also bring a small piece of one dark color

(she uses black) – along with your machine and the usual sewing supplies. If you have a $2\frac{1}{2}x$ 6 ½ inch ruler, bring that, too!!

In July, you can get out your Kaffe Fasset fabrics and join us for *Cosmos No Fear Curved Piecing*! I recommend this class highly because it will get you prepared for the August class with Peggy Martin – since we are going to do one of her medallion-style quilts that has curved piecing in it. I should have samples for both of these classes at the May meeting. Please come see me soon to sign up!
