• JUNE 20TH (SATURDAY): "GOODRICH/ATLAS IRON BELLE TRAIL"

• 4:00 PM

- RIDE WILL START AT THE GOODRICH COMMONS (PARK ENTRANCE AND PARKING IS ON ERIE STREET ACROSS FROM THE BUS GARAGE)
- WE WILL RIDE GALE AND PERRY ROAD WITH THE TURNAROUND AT MANCOUR
 - WE WILL HAVE A BRIEF DISCUSSION AT THE BRIDGE ON MANCOUR
 - THE RIDE WILL BE 10 MILES AND TAKE APPROX 1 HOUR

ABOUT GRID SPONSORED RIDES:

- OUR RIDES ARE "NO DROP" COMMUNITY/SOCIAL/FAMILY RIDES. THEY AVERAGE ABOUT 10MPH. WE WILL NEVER LEAVE A SLOWER RIDER BEHIND.
- WE TRY TO HAVE THEMES FOR OUR RIDES; LOCAL HISTORY, TRAIL EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT, LOCAL EVENTS, DESTINATIONS, ETC. SOME RIDES WILL HAVE STOPS FOR CONVERSATION. SOME ARE HELD IN CONJUNCTION WITH OUR COMMUNITY MEETINGS.
- RIDES TEND TO BE TRAIL ORIENTED; WHILE WE WILL SOMETIMES RIDE ON PORTIONS OF ROADS, WE WILL PRIMARILY RIDE ON TRAILS.
- WE'RE IN A LEARNING PROCESS; FEEDBACK WILL BE WELCOMED AFTER EACH RIDE.
