LumiQuick Donates Over 1.2 Million Rapid Antigen Tests to Support COVID-19 Response Efforts in California

Santa Clara, CA. Through a charitable campaign that ended recently, LumiQuick Diagnostics, Inc. (“LumiQuick”), the exclusive U.S. representative of Boson Biotech Co. Ltd., has donated over 1.2 million Boson™ Rapid SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Tests (the “Tests”) to Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (“LACDPH”, 668,000), San Francisco Chinese Hospital (“Chinese Hospital”, 210,000), AHMC Seton Medical Center (“Seton”, 210,000) and AHMC Health Foundation (“AHMCHF”, 126,000).

“LumiQuick is pleased to donate tests to community partners best equipped to get test kits into the hands of people who need them,” said Charles Yu, the CEO of LumiQuick. “With seasonal increases in COVID-19 cases nationwide and the continuous mutation of the virus like Omicron, regular testing plays an essential role in protecting people from infection and reducing the spread of this contagious disease. LumiQuick is honored to support our community in fighting the health and economic impacts of the pandemic.

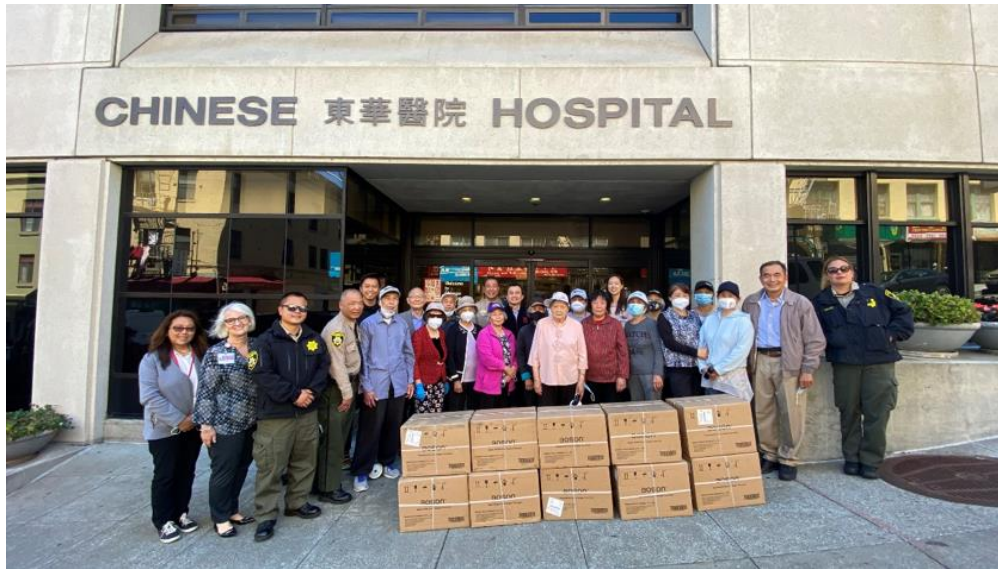
“The LA County Department of Public Health greatly appreciates the generous donation of 668,000 rapid antigen tests from LumiQuick Diagnostics Inc. to support our antigen test distribution efforts,” said Barbara Ferrer, PhD, MPH, MEd, Director of Public Health. “These free tests are distributed to communities hardest hit by COVID-19, and as we continue to promote self-testing with antigen tests as a means to slow the spread of infection, these resources will have a significant positive impact in many communities around the County which have the highest need to support reducing their risk of serious illness.”

LACDPH have distributed the donated Boson tests to department priority sectors in support of the testing at interim housing for the homeless, as well as Skilled Nursing Facilities, which have experienced substantial outbreaks and deaths over the course of the pandemic. They also distribute to agencies and organizations that serve the hardest-hit, lower income communities who are in need of free antigen tests to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19, including Community-Based Organizations, Community COVID-19 Testing Sites, Department of Public Health Centers, preschools and family child care sites, Faith-Based Organizations, Food Banks, Homeless Shelters & Domestic Violence Shelters, Long Term Care Facilities, Skilled Nursing Facilities, Senior Centers, etc.

“COVID-19 is still jeopardizing the health and well-being of our community. At this point, we are fortunate to have tools to keep our patients and community safe,” said Dr. Jian Zhang, Chinese Hospital CEO. “Philanthropy plays a vital role in fighting the pandemic. This is the single largest donation of medical supplies Chinese Hospital has received since the COVID-19 pandemic broke out in 2020. We are very thankful for LumiQuick for the much-needed rapid test kits because it’s important that everyone is able to receive testing when needed for early detection and prevention, especially given the Omicron surge.” The free COVID-19 antigen rapid test kits are available at Chinese Hospital’s clinics throughout San Francisco and Daly City. In addition, Chinese Hospital has also been distributing these rapid test kits to the those in



need in San Francisco Bay Area together with its community partners, including CCHP, Supervisor Aaron Peskin’s office, Supervisor Gordon Mar’s office, San Francisco Sheriff’s Department, Consulate-General of China in San Francisco, On Lok, Self-Help for the Elderly, Community Youth Center of San Francisco, API Council, Sam Yup Benevolent Association, Chinese Christian Union of San Francisco, local restaurants, and small businesses.

About the BOSON™ Rapid SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Test Card

Boson™ Rapid SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Test Card is a lateral flow immunoassay intended for the qualitative detection of nucleocapsid protein antigen from SARS-CoV-2. This test is authorized for non-prescription home use with self-collected anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 14 years or older when tested twice over three days with at least 24 hours (and no more than 48 hours) between tests. The test is authorized for individuals with symptoms of COVID-19 within the first 6 days of symptom onset, or without symptoms or other epidemiological reasons to suspect COVID-19.

This test is also intended for non-prescription home use with adult-collected anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 2 years or older when tested twice over three days with at least 24 hours (and no more than 48 hours) between tests. The test is authorized for individuals aged 2 years and older with symptoms of COVID-19 within the first 6 days of symptom onset, or individuals without symptoms or other epidemiological reasons to suspect COVID-19.
