Outline of Games for the STWGA 2025 Season

June 5: Opening Day: Texas Scramble in the 'Boat

All players tee off and the best drive is chosen. A minimum of 4 tee shots must be used by each player – that's the Texas way! Continue after tee shot by picking the best shot for every stroke.

Scoring: Lowest total team gross score wins (1st – 2nd).

June 12: Step Aside

Each player plays tees off on each hole. Team chooses the best drive. The player who hit the best drive "steps aside" - the remaining players hit the next shot. Team then chooses the best shot again – and the player who hit that shot "steps aside"; Repeat until the ball is holed.

Scoring: Each team record one score for each hole.

Scoring: Lowest total team score wins $(1^{st} - 2nd)$.

June 19: Criss Cross (Players with similar handicaps play together)

Player counts only 9 holes for this event (but all 18 holes can be entered for handicap scoring purposes). Players count their lowest score between each hole on the front nine and corresponding hole on the back nine to make their best nine-hole score. For example, the lowest score on 1&10, 2&11, 3&12, etc. (Note: no special consideration for the par of the hole, so if #1 is a par 3 and #10 is a par 5, you better score well on #1).

Scoring: Individual prizes are awarded for the best 2 gross and best 2 net scores.

June 26: Member/Member: Six Times Three

Pick another member to play with (note this as you register) for two-member teams. The first 6 holes are played alternate shot. At each hole, determine which player tees off, then alternate shots. The second 6 holes are played best ball. Each player plays their own ball for these 6 holes, and the best score is counted for each hole. The last 6 holes are played as a true scramble with both players teeing off and the best shot for each stroke.

Scoring: All of the above will be net scores based on the handicap of the two players. Lowest total net team score wins $(1^{st} - 2nd)$.

July 10: O.N.E.S

Each player plays their own ball for the full round.

The only holes that count are those holes that begin with a "O", "N", "E", and "S" (1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 16, 17, 18). Best two net scores for these holes count towards the team score.

Scoring: Lowest total net team score wins (1st – 2nd).

July 17: 3-3-3 (Players with similar handicaps play together)

Each player plays their own ball for the full round. For scoring each Player will take their best gross and best net score on Three Par 3's, Three Par 4's and Three Par 5's.

Scoring: Individual prizes are awarded for the best 2 gross and best 2 net scores.

July 24: 6 -6-6

The game is scored like standard two-person best ball, except who you're partnered with will change throughout the round. Within your foursome, players will pair up for six holes at a time as follows:

Holes 1 – 6: Players A/B vs. Players C/D; Holes 7 – 12: Players A/C vs. Players B/D; Holes 13-18: Players A/D and Players B/C;

The team that wins each hole (gross score) earns two points and the team that wins each hole (net score) earns one point. The player with the most points at the end of 18 holes wins.

Scoring: Individual prizes are awarded for the best 2 gross and best 2 net scores (based on total points).

July 29-31: Member/Guest

July 29: Optional

9 Hole Practice Round

Cocktails After Practice Round; Pay fees and check-in

July 30: 4 Club 9 Hole Event

Each player plays their own ball for the round carrying only 4 clubs.

Scoring: 2 Lowest gross scores are awarded prizes

Dinner/Betting/Check-in

July 31: Member / Guest Invitational

2-person best ball gross and net (same ball may be used for both scores)

Scoring: Prizes awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd best teams, gross and net

August 7: Nassau (Players with similar handicaps play together)

Each player plays their own ball for the full round. Three ways to win! Best front, Best Back and Best 18. Subtract ½ the handicap on nine, full handicap on 18.

Scoring: Individual prizes are awarded for the best 2 Best Front, 2 Best Back and 2 Best 18 (gross and net scores).

August 14: STWGA Club Champion

Each player plays their own ball for the full round.

Scoring: Individual prizes are awarded for the best 2 lowest Gross and 2 lowest Net.

August 21: Mystery 9 (Players with similar handicaps can play together)

Each player plays their own ball for the full round. Players record gross and net score on each hole. At the end of the round, numbers are pulled out of a bag (filled with the numbers 1 - 18) -the numbers will be the holes used for the competition.

Scoring: Individual prizes (1st and 2nd) awarded for the lowest gross and net on the Mystery 9.

August 28: Modified Waltz

Foursome event. Net score only. Score 1 best ball on Par 5's, 2 best balls on Par 4's and 3 best balls on Par 3's

Scoring: Lowest total team score wins $(1^{st} - 2^{nd} \text{ prizes})$.

Sept 4: Throw Out the Trash/Closing Meeting (Players with similar handicaps may play together)

Each player plays their own ball for the full round. Player is able to toss out one par three, two par fours and one par five at the end of the game.

Scoring: Individual prizes are awarded for the best 2 gross and best 2 net scores.

September 11: Even or Odd (Players with similar handicaps may play together)

Count only the Even holes on the front, and the Odd holes on the back – subtract ½ handicap.

Scoring: Individual prizes (1st, 2nd and 3rd) lowest net.
