



Fabric needed

: Dark Brown and Bright Scraps

Cutting instruction Scrap colors, you will need

FIVE 5-inch squares

Sub cut on the diagonal line.

You need(9) pieces.

dark Brown fabric You will need.

FIVE 5-inch squares

Follow instructions below and you will need nine finished HST's with one left over. Square units to 4 1/2 inches


You can use your Accuquilt or Go Baby, Use the 4 inch finished HST Die – Half Square Triangle – 4 inch finished square (55710) (Shape 3) in the 8 in cube


Piecing Instructions – Block


Take (1) 5" Color A square and (1) 5" Color B square Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the focus fabric squares. Place rightsides together with a background square. Stitch a ¼" inch on each side of the diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line. Press to the dark.











NOTE: BOM Requirements – When you enter the drawing and you win the drawing, you are obligated for the next twelve months to provide a block for the BOM drawing.

If your BOM quilt is completed in six months you will be presented with \$25. Contact Shron Jeans, Chair, to let her know you completed your quilt.
