

# BASIC PILLOWCASE PATTERN

## FABRIC —

- 1/4 yard — Fabric for Cuff
- 3/4 yard — Fabric for Main Body
- 1-1/2" strip — for Accent

## CUTTING —

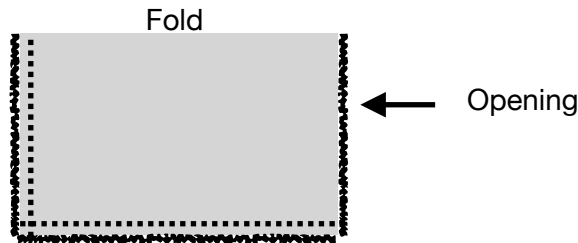
Measure width of fabric (WOF). When cutting, cut all pieces to the same width, in this case 42".

- Cut Body fabric — 26" x 42"
- Cut Cuff fabric — 8-1/2" x 42"

## ASSEMBLY

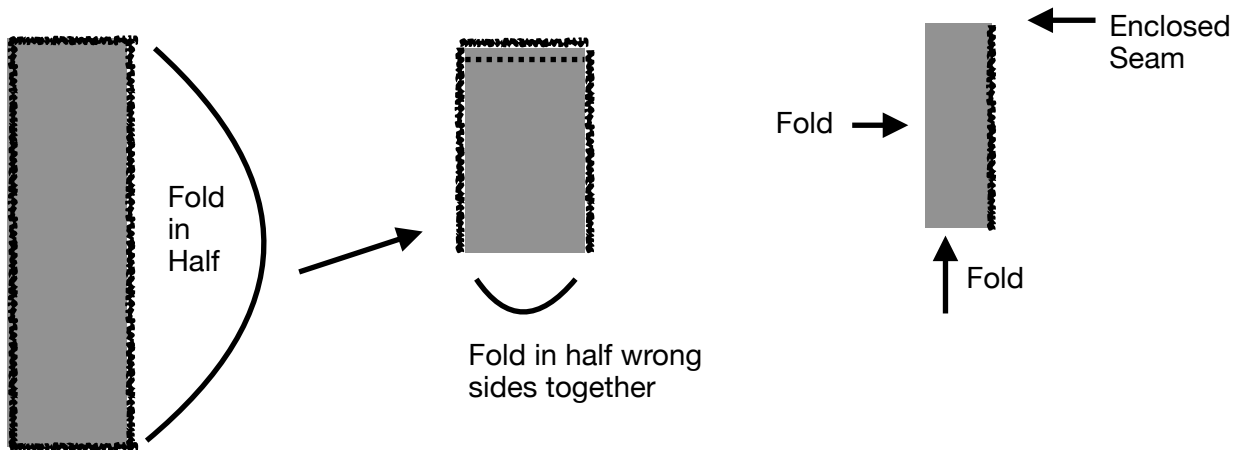
### STEP #1 — BODY

Body — fold right sides together lengthwise, serge or stitch across the bottom and side.



### STEP #2 — CUFF

Fold cuff in half right sides together. Serge or stitch the short end. Then turn cuff right side out, pressing the fold in the tube.



### STEP #3 — ASSEMBLE THE PILLOWCASE

Take the body 'tube' right sides together and insert cuff, right sides together with body and match raw edges in the 'tube'. Now stitch or serge around the cuff and body of the pillowcase. Turn right side out. Press the seam on the cuff toward the outside of the pillowcase and topstitch around the cuff and body with a decorative stitch.
