

Modified Co-Ed Rule (effective 2025)

Maximum **MALES** in the following lineup:

- 10 player line-up - 6 male maximum
- 12 player line-up - 7 male maximum

There is NO minimum males in the makeup of either lineup.

If there are 2 or less males in the lineup, the males can play anywhere on defense.

If there are 3 or more males in the lineup, there must be a male in the battery, a male in the infield and a male in the outfield.

NOTE: If a male player walks, and the next player is supposed to be a female and is not there, an automatic out is declared. That male batter that walked still get 2 bases, even though the next batter up to bat is a male after the automatic out.

Maximum **FEMALES** in all lineups:

- There is **NO** maximum females in the makeup of either lineup.
- Both the 10 player and 12 player lineups may be of all females.

Substitutes must be of the same gender.

Courtesy Runners: One for each gender in an inning.

When playing with a 12-player lineup, player leaves the game for whatever reason and there is NO substitute, the following player must also leave the lineup but may continue to play defense. There is NOT to be an 11-player lineup.

If line-up is dropped to a 9-player lineup, there shall be an automatic out recorded in that vacant spot in the lineup.

Lineup may not have 3 males bat consecutively.
