Softball Turnback Policy

DEFINITIONS

Turnback: An accepted assignment that has been returned to the

Softball Assignor to be reassigned.

Proper Turnback: A turnback that is made by speaking directly with the

Assignor, either in person or on the phone and within the

guidelines of the established turnback policy.

Policy: Each umpire shall be granted two turnbacks a year,

provided it is with at least 48 hours notice before the

scheduled start time of said assignment.

After those two turnbacks or for any turnback within 48 hours of the assignment, a grievance may be filed against

you in accordance with the By-Laws.

An assignment turned back with notice of less that 48 hours is subject to a maximum fine of the game fee(s) and

the assignor's fee(s).

Softball Assignor, upon request from an umpire shall provide a list of umpires that may be called as substitutes for a particular assignment. With this assistance, you are encouraged to find your own replacement. Said list shall be provided from the list of umpires that had originally specified the date of assignment in their availability, but does not guarantee that the listed umpires are still

available.
