## Here I am. Send Me!

Isaiah 6:8 "Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here am I. Send me!'"

The Walks are almost here! Your Cross Point Emmaus Board is very excited to see what God has in store for the men and women of Walk 107 and 108. Applications have steadily been submitted by those eager to deepen their relationship with Christ.

Amongst the excitement for the Emmaus Walks, have you considered your Fourth Days? Whether you attended Walk 1 or Walk 106, our Fourth Days are important. How have you lived out yours? Have you allowed your Emmaus experience to drift into obscurity or has the revelation of God's grace upon your life been evident in each day? Have you woke each morning by answering God's call on your life, with "Here am I. Send me!"? I haven't been faithful to do so every morning of my Fourth Days. Sometimes my calendared plans and appointments overshadow the stillness of God's grace on my life and I quickly forget what I have been called to accomplish. To simply live in grace. I get caught up in my routines that I don't see the task before me of simply loving those around me my children, family, friends, coworkers, strangers at the store. I hope your Fourth Days have been filled with the expectation of the Spirit moving through you and around you, by you responding with "Send Me!"

#### Walk Fees:

Volunteer fee: \$175

Pilgrim fee: \$190 (\$95 deposit)

These fees cover lodging, meals, insurance, literature, and supplies.

Deadline for all fees to be paid is March 16th. That is also the deadline for all pilgrim and sponsor applications. If you are still considering sponsoring someone, please meet with them and get their applications submitted as soon as possible. The Walks are filling up quickly and your candidate may end up on a waiting list if you procrastinate.

Sponsors, I hope you have maintained contact with your candidate and are preparing them for successful participation. Please plan to attend Sponsor's Hour after Send Off on Thursday night. This is an important part of your responsibility as a sponsor.

Thank you to everyone who is already supporting the Walks, pilgrims, sponsors, and volunteers. Thank you for your willingness to say "Here am I. Send Me!"



#### On the Road to Emmaus

<sup>13</sup> Now that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles<sup>[a]</sup> from Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup> They were talking with each other about everything that had happened. <sup>15</sup> As they talked and discussed these things with each other, Jesus himself came up and walked along with them; <sup>16</sup> but they were kept from recognizing him.

<sup>28</sup> As they approached the village to which they were going, Jesus continued on as if he were going farther. <sup>29</sup> But they urged him strongly, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening; the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them.

<sup>30</sup> When he was at the table with them, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it and began to give it to them. <sup>31</sup> Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight. <sup>32</sup> They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"
