

Image Copyright & Usage Policy – Jeneva LaTina Photography

1. Copyright Ownership

All photographs are protected under United States copyright law. The photographer retains full copyright ownership of all images.

2. Client Usage Rights

Clients receive a license to use images based on their agreement, such as personal use, social media sharing, website display, or licensed marketing use.

3. Image Editing

Images may not be altered, filtered, cropped, or modified without permission from the photographer.

4. Photographer Promotional Rights

Jeneva LaTina Photography may display photographs for portfolio, marketing, social media, or promotional purposes unless otherwise agreed.

5. Copyright Violations

Unauthorized reproduction or commercial usage of images may result in legal action.

Model Release Policy – Jeneva LaTina Photography

When a Model Release Is Required

Model releases may be required for advertising photography, brand campaigns, editorial publications, and marketing materials.

Portfolio and Promotional Use

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, clients grant permission for images to be used for portfolio display, website galleries, and promotional materials.

Minors

If a photographed individual is under 18, a parent or legal guardian must sign a model release.

Commercial Projects

For commercial assignments with multiple participants, the client may be responsible for collecting model releases unless arranged otherwise.
