

BLACK DIAMOND FOUNDATION, INC. 2019 IN REVIEW

Surpassing \$2.4 million in grants to Citrus County charities and organizations is a highlight of 2019! Thanks to the many residents of Black Diamond who contribute to efforts to achieve the Foundation's mission to show that the Black Diamond community cares.

Total revenue for 2019 was \$178,578. The main component of that revenue continues to be contributions from the Black Diamond community, which totaled \$158,295. We did not hold a major fundraiser in 2019, but the 2019 revenues did contain some revenue and expense from the November 2018 Pro-Am and the January 20, 2020 Pro-Am.

Your Foundation awarded twenty-one grants totaling \$197,813. Recipients were as follows:

Aspire Relationship Center-\$10,000 to support its healthy relationship training in middle and high schools.

Boys & Girls Clubs of Citrus County, Inc.-\$10,000 to support its Morning Program.

Citrus County Blessings-\$5,000 to purchase food for its weekend backpack program.

Citrus County Education Foundation-\$12,000 to support the teacher mini grant and First Library programs.

Citrus County Family Resource Center-\$5,000 to purchase food for its food pantry.

Citrus County Sheriff's Office-\$8,000 to acquire a K-9 deputy for the force.

Community Food Bank of Citrus County-\$21,380 to support the lease of a new truck for one year, plus a donor directed contribution.

Daystar Life Center of Citrus County-\$10,000 to pave the parking lot and access roads.

Girl Scout Troop #10440-\$1,500 to support the Light Your Way for a Safe Education project which will provide LED illuminated reflectors to students.

Mission United-\$5,000 to support its program to assist veterans in need.

Moffitt Cancer Center-\$3,503 to fulfill a donor directed contribution.

Nature Coast Ministries-\$13,000 to support operations of the free dental clinic, plus a donor directed contribution.

Rotary of Central Citrus County Foundation-\$5,750 to fulfill a donor directed contribution.

The Salvation Army of Citrus County-\$5,200 to fulfill donor directed contributions.

Serving Our Savior, Inc.-\$15,000 to purchase food for its food pantry.

Take Stock in Children-\$10,000 for scholarships.

Thanksgiving Feeding Alliance-\$3,000 a community challenge grant to pay for turkeys.

The Path of Citrus County-\$5,000 to pay the second part of a challenge grant to purchase a new freezer.

The Pregnancy and Family Life Center-\$5,000 to purchase diapers, wipes and food for its outreach programs.

Withlacoochee Technical College-\$15,000 to support scholarships, and other educational expenses such as instructional materials and equipment and paying fees for industry testing and certifications.

YMCA of the Suncoast, Citrus Branch-\$29,480 to support the Academic Enrichment Program, plus donor directed contributions.
