Black Diamond Foundation March 2025 Update

It's been a busy March for Black Diamond golf events and a busy March for the Black Diamond Foundation.

Community Food Bank of Citrus County gathers unused/unsold food from Citrus and surrounding county grocery stores, sorts it in their two large Homosassa warehouses, and then distributes the food to 40+ Citrus County food pantries. The \$40,000 grant from Black Diamond Foundation helps keep the truck fleet on the road, support warehouse operations and pay down the warehouse mortgage. In 2024, Community Food Bank distributed 4.6 million pounds of food.

Citrus County Education Foundation was awarded a \$19,000 grant to help fund mini-grant programs for classroom teachers, books for pre-K and kindergarten students, the community of care program and golden citrus scholarship program. CCEF's community impact goes far beyond the classrooms as they are very active in identifying and rehousing homeless families with children.

It was an exceptionally busy month for Conquering Cancer in Citrus County as the 4C volunteers raised \$83,000 (and still growing) to support local cancer charities. We've added links below for four new 4C sponsors.
