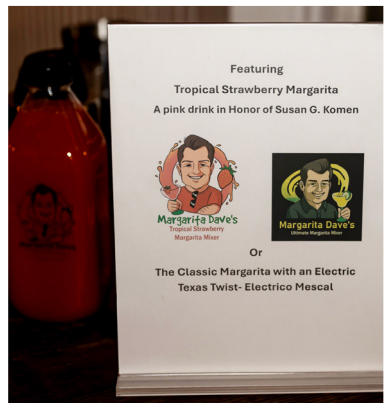
This concert was more than entertainment; it was a reminder of the strength found in community. May all those battling cancer, or supporting someone who is, feel lifted by the love we shared that night.
