Division Of the Land of Elizabeth Odom

Elizabeth Odom, daughter of Moses and Elizabeth (Betsey) Clifton Odom, was deceased before 1852. She left 59 acres land to be divided between her three sisters - Lydia, Martha, and Susan and brother Charles Odom. This land was probably that which she purchased from Abner Perry 14 April 1845.

Lydia Odom of Northampton Co. sold three tracts of land to her brother Charles Odom for \$100.

1st tract land in Northampton Co. being said Lydia Odom's distributive share in 59 acres land belonging to Elizabeth Odom ~~at~~ her death descended to heirs of Elizabeth Odom at her death - 143/4 acres adjoining lands of Jesse Wilks and J.J. Horton.

~~2nd~~ tract in Hartford Co. adjoining lands of Uriah Marsh, heirs of Langley Tayloe, Aaron Parker and others known as a part of the Bruce Place - 45 acres

2nd tract 33 acres in Northampton Co.

Martha Odom of Northampton Co. sold to Charles Odom of Northampton Co. her undivided interest in land being said Martha Odom's distributive share in 59 acres - land belonging to Elizabeth Odom, deceased and descended to heirs of Elizabeth Odom at her death - 143.4 acres for \$50 being in Northampton Co. adjoining lands of Jesse Wilks, J.J. Horton and lands of Lydia Odom

Susan Odom of Northampton Co. sold to Charles Odom of Northampton Co. her undivided interest in lands of Elizabeth Odom of Northampton Co. deceased, descended to heirs of Elizabeth Odom at her death - 143 acres for \$50 being her distributive share of 59 acres.

Susan Odom, daughter of Moses and Elizabeth Clifton Odom continued,

Susan Odom did not marry. She continued to live with her brother Charles Odom and family. She died will probated 26 Feb. 1889.

Will of Susan Odom

I Susan Odom a born native of the County of Hertford and State of North Carolina and now residing in the aforesaid county and State and being sound in mind and memory but knowing that life is uncertain and that death is inevitable do make and declare this to be my last will as follows.

1st I will give devise bequeath my estate and property both personal and real if any as follows-

2nd- My Executor is hereby authorized to provide for my body a decent burial and after the cost together with my debts if any. Then the balance of my Estate is to be disposed of as hereinafter described and specified.

To

3rd- To my sister Martha Odom I will give and bequeath one half the net proceeds of my Estate to her during her life time and after her death to the heirs of my brother Charles Odom, deceased.

4th To Moses F.S.Odom, Elizabeth C.Odom, Lydia A.Odom and Charles R. Odom heirs of my brother Charles Odom, deceased I will give and bequeath the remaining half of the net proceeds of my Estate to be equally divided between them according to law.

5th - I hereby appoint Charles Odom as my Executor to settle my Estate both personal and real if any in accordance with my will as heretofore described and specified according to law. In witness whereof I have hereunto signed and sealed this instrument and published and declared the same as and for my last will.

Lydia Odom continued

Lydia Odom, daughter of Moses and Elizabeth Clifton Odom, was living at her old Odom home when she married Jan. 21, 1869 Josiah Rawls, Sr. son of Jimmy Rawls of Hertford Co. They lived in Bertie county. After his death Nov. 1871 Lydia Odom Rawls returned to her old home.

Charles Odom and wife Mary Pp Odom sold 100 acres land for \$500 to Lydia (Odom) Rawls (his sister) adjoining lands of J.J. Horton to road leading from Roxobel to Winton, thence down the road to Mill Branch to Horton and Odom corner to the beginning
Book C page 31 made 28 oct 1873 Hertford Co.

Lydia (Odom) Rawls of "Hertford Co. died Nov. 1882. In her will "I lend unto my nephew Joseph A. Odom (son of Etheldred) one certain tract of land 100 acres during his natural life and unto his wife Frusie Ann Odom if she should be left a widow during her widowhood Then I give unto all of Joseph A Odom's children the land to hold in fee simple".

Josiah Rawls, Sr. married 2nd Jan. 21, 1869 Lydia Odom, dt of Moses and Elizabeth Clifton Odom

In his will dated Nov. 7, 1871 prob. Dec 29, 1871 Book I page 41 Bertie Co. Josiah Rawls, Sr. leaves half of personal property to wife Lydia (Odom) Rawls and he gives to Joseph A Odom (son of Etheldred) after the death of my wife Lydia Rawls "a tract of land lying over the Branch known by name Gabrush Tract containing 40 acres."

Note: Joseph A Odom married Frusie Ann Rawls, daughter of Jimmy and sister to Josiah Rawls. Joseph A Odom and Frusie Ann Rawls Odom were the parents of Martha (Mattie) Jane Odom who married Moses E.S. Odom - Linwood Odom's Parents.

Etheldred Odom continued

Etheldred Odom, son of Moses and Sarah? Martin Odom,
married 21 March 1831 Celia Bruce, dt of Bennet Bruce, Hertford Co
Lived in Northampton Co. near Old Odom homesite .
