I am **Kalebu Henry**. I was born in **1979** and I have 40 years of age. I have two children. I was born in Kyebanga village in **Mpigi District**. I went to school but I stopped In Primary three due to lack of school fees.

I was raised by only **my mother since** my father had died. My mother taught me farming and how to dig plus selling Agricultural produce. I moved away fro home and went to start stone Quarrying where I used to get some money. Time reached and I went back home.

That is the time I was arrested and was taken to prison for **10 years**. They imprisoned for mob justice and I was found guilty and sentenced for **Life Imprisonment**. When I was too idle in prison, I decided to join others to start working in Carpentry.

Ever since I joined Carpentry, I have never got more worries since my minds concentrate on what am doing. I have learnt many skills such as Grinding. I do quality work for my bosses and they appreciate me sometimes by giving me some soap and ever since I joined Carpentry, I have never eaten un fried beans and there are many prisoners who would like to eat fried beans but they can not.

Carpentry has helped me and I have hope that if court calls me, I will be helped by Court of Appeal. And if I am released, I will continue doing my Job of Carpentry since I have gained enough experience. This will help me take care of my children since they have not gained from me as a parent and they don't admire to be like me.
