

MALOME RAMATHAN'S STORY

I was born in 1962 in Bulambuli district (Formerly Bugisu/ Mbale district)

I attended Nabbongo Primary school in my village where I sat for my Primary Leaving Examinations (PLE) In 1983. I did not pursue any further Formal education due to the large size of my family and the limited Financial resources my Father had.

When I dropped out of school, I engaged in full time subsistence farming and traded some of the produce.

I later moved to Tororo District where I was employed as a Commercial truck driver by a business man in the commercial town. I married two wives with whom I have six children.

In 2005, I was arrested on allegations of having been involved in the murder of a relative of mine and detained at Maluku prison in **Mbale for seven years until 2012.**

When I was **convicted** and sentenced to 25 years imprisonment. I was transferred to upper prison **Luzira.**

While in the upper prison, I enrolled to train in the tailoring department where I have gained valuable tailoring skills. I can draft and join and also do other basic and intermediate tailoring clothes. I tailor both prisons officer's and inmates uniforms since 2015 up to date.

I would be very grateful if given a chance to improve on my skills through further Vocational training.
